Title: [A Blueprint for Responsible Oil Sands Development](#)

As the debate around oil sands development grows increasingly polarized, there has been remarkably little analysis around what can be done to improve the policy framework under which the oil sands are developed. This presentation will present Pembina Institute's perspective on the current and future environmental impacts of oil sands development and propose what improvements could help address the deteriorating reputation of the oil sands development around the world.



Simon Dyer is the Oil Sands Program Director at the Pembina Institute in Calgary. Simon is a registered professional biologist and has worked on natural resource management issues in western Canada for the past decade. Simon holds a Master of Science in environmental biology and ecology from the University of Alberta, and a Master of Arts in natural sciences from Cambridge University in the UK. Simon has represented Pembina Institute in numerous regulatory, legal and government hearings concerning oil sands development and is the co-author of over a dozen publications addressing ways to improve the policy environment governing oil sands development.
